

100% CLUB AWARD

CONTEST PERIOD: July 1 through June 30

CHAIRMAN: Contest & Award Chairman

PURPOSE: To encourage Clubs (Lions, Lioness, and Leos) to become more involved in their communities and District. Any Club which accumulates 1000 points using the following rules will be recognized as a 100% Club.

OFFICIAL POINT SYSTEM:

Judging will be based on a point system as follows.

Activities must be reported in the monthly MMR & Activities Report to be credited.

1. Hosting or sponsoring a YE Student, or other youth activity, such as youth counseling, a Lions Quest class, LEO Club, Scout Troop, 4-H, etc100 points
2. Attending any Zone Meeting with 10% of the July membership.....100 points
3. Attending any Cabinet Meeting with 10% of the July membership100 points
4. President or Secretary attending a District Training Course. Each100 points
5. Participation in any NCLSA, LPCCI, LEF, Deaf Camp or FPVI fund-raiser with 10% of the July membership100 points
6. Membership
 - a. For every new member which is a net gain as of June 30.....100 points
 - b. For each new member sponsored into any other Club in the district.....100 points
7. Completing a community service project, in which at least 10% of the July membership participates. (A community service project is one that serves the community, rather than a person, i.e., school, park, etc.).....50 points
8. Participating in an on-going service project, in which at least 33% of the July membership participates, such as hospital service, convalescent home service, transporting ill persons, etc. (An on-going project is one not completed between July 1 and June 30).100 points
9. Participating in a fund raising effort for the Zone, Region, District or International, with 10% of the July membership.....100 points
10. Participating in World Service Day, in October, with a work project in the community, Start-A-Heart or CPR Saturday50 points
11. Club qualifying for any Visitation Award100 points
12. President or Secretary qualifying as 100% in the District contest. Each.....100 points
13. Organizing and chartering a new Lions, Lioness or LEO club, each.....200 points
14. Participating in White Cane Days.....50 points
15. Holding a Student Speaker Contest at your club.....50 points

BONUS

1. Sponsoring or participating in a LMEAF fund-raiser with 10% of the July membership.
 2. Participate in a Work project at Camp Ross Relles with 10% of your July Membership.
 3. Sponsoring or participating in the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation Walk for the Cure with 10% of the July membership or with a donation of \$300
- Each.....100 points

“A minimum of three (3) members, or 10% of the April membership, whichever is greater, must participate for points to be awarded for items marked with an asterisk ().”*
