

PARTNER IN SERVICE RECOGNITION

CONTEST PERIOD: April 1 through March 31

CHAIRMAN: Cabinet Secretary

ENTRY INFORMATION: These rules apply to candidates for the Partner in Service Award. There will be one individual selected as the District Award winner. This award is to recognize and appreciate the partner who is not a Lion, Lioness or LEO. The winner is an active partner in supporting the Lions member in Lionism. This support includes participating in Club and District activities including fund raisers, attendance at meetings and conventions at the District, Multiple District and International levels. The award winner is involved in community service outside of the Lions Club, exemplifying Lionism in action. The partners of the District Governor and Vice District Governor are not eligible for this award.

NOMINATION: Summarized score sheet and a brief resume. The nomination must be in the hands of the Cabinet Secretary by April 8.

PARTICIPATION: Assisted in Club or District activity. Each10 points.....Maximum200 points

ATTENDANCE: Club meeting or fundraiser attended.

Each 05 points.....Maximum..... 100 points

Zone, Cabinet or District meeting or fundraiser attended. Each10 points.....Maximum 100 points

USA/Canada Forum or International, MD-4, or District Convention

Each.....25 points.....Maximum100 points

ACTIVITIES: For each activity of Community Service, outside of local Lions Club that exemplifies Lionism in action. Each....20 points...Maximum ...100 points

Scoring and summation of points accumulated, must be signed by the President and the members of the Board.

RESUME: A brief Resume consisting of a biography of the nominee and their involvement over the years. This short biography should embellish upon the attributes that make this individual a candidate for the award.

OFFICIAL POINT SYSTEM

JUDGING

1. The **points scored** and the description in the **RESUME** will be used with **equal weight** as a basis of judgment.
2. The Executive board will recommend to the Governor their Selections
3. The District Governor will select the "Partner-in-service of the Year."
