Lions Wilderness Camp for DEAF Children is a 501(c)3 charity foundation formed under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law, founded in 1980 and endorsed by MD-4. Camps are held in the north and south part of the state. Dedicated people, highly proficient in sign language, staff the camps. The children are taught about nature, outdoor living skills and recreation. Through these activities, the camp experience becomes a way to assist the camper build self-esteem and gain confidence. Leadership development is also offered to experienced campers who volunteer as Counselors in Training (CIT's). Lion volunteers are welcome to help with various phases of camp.
