**Convention Site Selection Committee**  
**Increase in Eligible Sites**

**Status Quo**

**Article VI Conventions**

**sec. 1.** The District Governor shall hold an annual convention in the spring of each year but in no case shall it conclude less than fifteen (15) days prior to the convention of Lions International. Recommendations for the final two (2) sites of said convention shall be selected at least two (2) years in advance by the delegates of the previous convention.

**Proposed Amendment**

**Article VI Conventions**

**sec. 1.** The District Governor shall hold an annual convention in the spring of each year but in no case shall it conclude less than fifteen (15) days prior to the convention of Lions International. Recommendations for the final three (3) sites of said convention shall be selected at least two (2) years in advance by the delegates of the previous convention.

Net effect of proposed change;

In order to give the Site selection committee additional flexibility in negotiating with potential sites for upcoming conventions the top Three (3) sites recommended by the membership/delegates instead of Two (2), shall be eligible for consideration.

The only fiscal impact of this change is greater negotiating power with and competition among Bidding sites.
